### **Retired Athletes Transformation Programme (RATP) 2018-2021**

#### **Programme Objective**

The "Retired Athletes Transformation Programme" (RATP), organised by Home Affairs Bureau and administrated by HKACEP, encourages and subsidises schools and sports organisations to employ retired athletes. The programme aims to facilitate retired athletes' career development by providing them a platform to earn work experience, supplemented with on-job training and education subsidies for their academic enhancement. On the other hand, this programme helps schools and sports associations to promote sports and nurture sports talents.

#### **Retired athletes wish to enroll in the programme have to fulfill with the following qualifications**

- Must be retired athletes;
- Have retired for no more than six years by the time of making first application under the Programme\*;
- Have attained secondary education;
- Have received at least two years of training for senior athletes\*; and
- Have represented Hong Kong at least once in an international competition (including the National Games or the National Championships)\*

\*A confirmation signed by the relevant national sports association (NSA) in the application form is required.

HK\$17,000 - 24,200 (Subject to years of training and working experience)
